**From Stroudsburg:** Take I-80 to 209 North (Exit 309) and travel through Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area. At light in Milford continue straight onto Harford Street; follow signs to Grey Towers. Bear left on Old Owego Turnpike.

**From Scranton:** Take I-84 East to Exit 46, Milford. Bear right off ramp onto Highway 6 East. Make sharp right onto Old Owego Turnpike after Apple Valley Restaurant.

**From New York State:** Take I-84 West to Exit 46, Milford, PA. Turn left off ramp onto Highway 6 East. Make sharp right onto Old Owego Turnpike after Apple Valley Restaurant.
